National IBP Conference

The Academy of Science, through its National Committee for the IBP, will hold a symposium entitled "Biology in the Modern World" on Thursday 16 November at the Academy building in Canberra, commencing at 10 a.m. It is intended that the symposium should launch the operational phase of the Australian programme, and at the same time serve as a focus for a modest public relations programme aimed at promoting the IBP, and indirectly biology in general.
