THE SOCIAL WELFARE ORDINANCE 1964

Under the provisions of Section 17 (1) of the Social Welfare Ordinance 1964, permission is hereby granted to:-

at *Bathurst Island Mission* for the purpose of
I. B. P. human adaptability
project

This permit is effective from *14 July 1969* to *14 July 1969*
and is revocable at will by the Director of Social Welfare for
the Northern Territory or by his delegate.

A chest X-ray was taken on *N/A*

NOTE:

- (a) A chest X-ray is required where an applicant for a permit intends to remain on a Reserve longer than one month.
- (b) If you have been in contact with any infectious disease within the last three weeks or if you are suffering from an infectious disease (e.g. Measles, Influenza, Chicken Pox etc.) this permit is no longer valid since such diseases become very serious and may even prove fatal in Aboriginal people.
- (c) If you have had Malaria in the last three years or have lived in a Malarious area in that time, you are asked to advise the Director of Social Welfare
